

How To Grow Strawberries

Crop management

Unlike for some other crops, prevent water logging in the garden of strawberries and mulch for fruits to rest on them to prevent rotting due to contact with soils. Soak seedlings in sea weed solution for 5 minutes to strengthen the roots, chop off flowers from seedlings and plant with crowns above soil levels to prevent flowers from rotting.

Similarly, strawberries are strong feeders which need different fertilizers and a farmer should apply phosphate fertilizers during planting and potassium during fruiting. Water plants after fertilizer application and put mulch in the garden trenches and chaff around plants.

Furthermore, water after application of chaffs and mulch to stop them from flying away and finally cover strawberry garden to prevent intruders.
