

How to Prune Cherry Trees for Maximum Production

Cherry management

As a farmer applies grafting compound on open cut wounds of cherry trees, she should cut off all branches that grow horizontal to the ground and leave 0.5 inches of branch cuts from the trunk and also cut off dead branches and branches that grow towards inside to avoid crowding.

Similarly, tree produce fruits after 3 years from pruning. Select a cherry variety to pollinate with and don't over prune the cherry tree after last heavy pruning.
