

»Neem oil for plants how to use«

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There a lot of harmful insects and soil fungus which always eat our plant leaves and roots. If we are growing any plants, it is our responsibility to save our plants from such kind of difficult problems.

The organic way that can help us keep our plants safe from such kind of harmful insects and fungal diseases is by use of neem oil. Neem oil contains azadirachtin, component which act like mind disturbing agent for many insects. With this most insects forget to eat and go about multiplication activities. It also prevents their eggs to reach hatching stages. Neem oil does not affect earth worms and beneficial pollinators like bees and butterflies so plant growth continues.

Using neem oil

Neem oil control more than 200 harmful insects and soil fungus which eat our plants on regular basis. Therefore neem oil is the best organic choice in saving our plants from insects and fungus.

Due to lack of information, one may not get the perfect result and in some cases plants also decay. Neem oil is used as a treatment agent when plants are already affected. Always try to use neem oil as a preventive measure at least twice a month. It will help keep insects away from plants.

Using neem oil

Use of medically preferred neem oil may damage and hurt the plants. Always use agriculture base neem oil which comes in water soluble form.

Use neem oil when the sun has already risen and temperature also high. Neem oil also gets warm along with increasing temperature and start damaging plants. Always use neem oil spray either very early in the morning or late evening.

Preparing neem oil

To prepare neem oil, take required amount of clean water and mix with agriculture base neem oil. Mixing proportion should be 2.5 milliliters of neem oil for every one litre of water. Mix it properly with water. Once the solution is ready, you can now use it on plants.
