

Yard Long Beans Farming | How to grow Long Beans at Home | Organic Snake Beans Cultivation

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Yard long beans is a pulse. Pulses naturally contribute to enhancing soil with nutrients and increasing next crop yields. This reduces the need for fertilizers.

Before sowing the yard long bean seeds, till the entire farm. Then make a bed and install a drip irrigation system. After that cover the bed and drip system with plastic mulch. Mulching reduces the requirement for water and eliminates weeds at the base part of yard long bean plant. Then make holes in mulch and sowed seeds. Make plastic rope mesh to climb back and cover the plant at the top.

Crop Rotation

Yard beans is a three months crop. You will start getting yield within 1 month after seed sowing. After 3 months, you can sow new seeds at the base of the existing plant. So you can do at least 3 crops in one year.

Use organic pest traps to get rid of pests.
